The Center is on the front lines daily ministering to the homeless and underprivileged communities. We provide basic survival needs, information on community services and respectful human interaction.

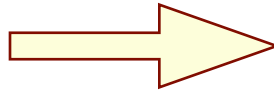
COMMUNITY
